NOW IT PAYS TO BE GREEN

There are two UK government incentive schemes currently available for installing energy efficient products for which you may be eligible:

The Renewable Heat Incentive (RHI) The RHI is available for installations of both Wood Pellet Boilers and Solar Thermal systems and just about everyone could be eligible, from domestic households and landlords, to businesses, farms, schools, hospitals and care homes.

Renewable Heat Premium Payment (RHPP)

The Renewable Heat Premium Payment is a one-off grant designed to help meet the costs of installing renewable technologies in your home, until the Renewable Heat Incentive (RHI) is introduced for domestic customers in 2014.



CONVERTIBLE HAND-FILL BOILER

New to the UK, the ÖkoFEN Convertible Hand-Fill Boiler is an ideal entry-level wood pellet boiler. As its name suggests, this boiler can be filled by hand, so it requires less space and is a cheaper option than the automatic-fill products. And, as its name again suggests, it is suitable for conversion to automatic-fill at a later date. So if you know anyone who would like to benefit from this technology - but thought they couldn't afford it, or didn't have the space - this could be just the news they've been waiting for!
